

**Dr. Holger Müller, LL.M.**

Dr. Holger Müller is admitted to practice as an attorney at the *Kammergericht* (Court of Appeals) and *Landgericht* (Higher Regional Court) in Berlin. After completing his legal studies at the University of Heidelberg and Münster in Germany (1990-1994), he obtained a Master of Laws (LL.M.) at the University of British Columbia in Vancouver, Canada, in 1994/95. Subsequently, he gained broad experience in the field of international commercial law as a staff member of the law firm Lovells Boesebeck Droste in Düsseldorf and Berlin.

In 1998 he passed his Second Legal State's Examination (final professional qualification) and was awarded his doctorate degree from the University of Münster for a dissertation on "The Resolution of Commercial Law Disputes within NAFTA, with Special Reference to the Role of Arbitration".

Subsequently, he worked for two years as an attorney for the law firm Richter Seiler Jenckel Bremer (now Hogan & Hartson Raue L.L.P.) in Berlin, specializing in corporate and media law. Furthermore, he also worked for the legal department of Sportgate AG and eBay GmbH. Today, Dr. Müller – as a partner at Schlüschen Müller Dierksmeier – focuses on consultancy in the fields of law mentioned above, particularly also in the areas of foundation law and online media law as well as on matters concerning business contacts and emigration to Canada, the United States, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa.

He is a member of the Canadian German Lawyers' Association (CGLA) as well as of the German American Lawyers' Association (GALA).
