

**Ground Transportation to Harrison Hot Springs from Vancouver:**

**Option # 1: Conference buses from/ to the Vancouver Airport:**

- Depart Comfort Inn (downtown Vancouver on Nelson/Granville 654 Nelson Street, Vancouver, BC) 5:30 p.m.

**Thursday, June 30**

- Depart Harrison Hot Springs Hotel for YVR (no other drop-offs): 8:00 a.m.

**Option #2: Airport Link shuttle:** phone # 604 594 3333, needs 24 hour notice when booking (probably about \$60.00 each way)

**Option # 3: buses** From Vancouver, the Greyhound Bus Service, 1 800 661 8747 or the Chilliwack station is 604 858 7733. After arriving at Chilliwack's station, a local transit bus is needed and they can be reached at 604 795 3838.

**Option #4: Car rental:** various rental companies at Vancouver airport and elsewhere - Driving directions: <http://www.harrisonresort.com/directions/>

**Option #5: Limousine:** Limo rental can be quite expensive but may be cost effective for those at odd times and sharing the cost (many Antipodean flights may arrive in the morning hours). Anticipate rates from around \$200 for a “8” seater car (that can probably hold six people plus luggage – check when booking). The conference cannot recommend any company.
