SEPTEMBER

Saturday, 1 September 2007

GALA – International Orientation for new international (including US) and exchange students continues (August 30 to September 1).

Monday, 3 September 2007

Labour Day. University closed.

Tuesday, 4 September 2007

2007/2008 Academic Year begins.

Law, first year: Orientation begins.

Law, second and third years: Classes begin.

Wednesday, 5 September 2007

Last day for payment of first installment of fees for registration and course changes made before September 1st. Students who have not paid their fees will be placed on financial hold: further registration activity will not be permitted, grades will not be released, and graduation diplomas will be withheld. Students will also be assessed a processing fee of \$30.00 and interest will be assessed on the outstanding balance until it is paid in full (see Calendar Chapter 3).

Monday, 17 September 2007

General University Bursaries: Last day for applications to be submitted to Student Financial Assistance and Awards. Students must have received their 2007/2008 student loans to be eligible for the General Bursaries.

Friday, 5 October 2007

Last day for payment of fees for any fee assessments incurred between September 1 and September 30. Students who have not paid their fees will be placed on financial hold: further registration activity will not be permitted, grades will not be released and graduation diplomas will be withheld. Students will also be assessed a processing fee of \$30.00 and interest will be assessed on outstanding balance until it is paid in full (see Calendar Chapter 3).

Last date for withdrawal from most Winter Session Term 1 courses with withdrawal standing of "W" recorded on a student's academic record.
