### **SEPTEMBER**

**Wednesday, 1 September 2010**

2010/11 Academic Year begins.

**Thursday, 2 September 2010**

GALA: International Student Orientation for new international (including US) and exchange students begins (September 2 to September 4 inclusive).

UBC Student Housing and Hospitality Services: Residences open.

**Last day for payment of fees for any fee assessments incurred between September 1 and September 30. Students who have not paid their fees will be placed on financial hold; further registration activity will not be permitted, grades will not be released, and graduation diplomas will be withheld. Students will also be assessed a processing fee of \$35.00 and interest will be assessed on outstanding balance until it is paid in full (see [Fees](#)).**
