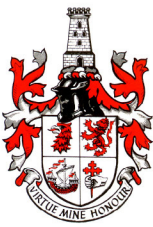

## Self-Dealing and Indirect Conflicts

An important concern for policymakers around the world is preventing controlling shareholders from using self-dealing transactions to expropriate outside investors. But what is the proper legal distinction between corporate business decisions and self-dealing or conflicted transactions? Drawing on legal developments in Delaware and elsewhere, the presentation will offer a new approach that would allow courts to identify self-dealing transactions.

Assaf Hamdani is the Wachtell, Lipton, Rosen & Katz Professor of Corporate Law at the Faculty of Law, Hebrew University and a research associate of the European Corporate Governance Institute (ECGI). His research on corporate governance, regulatory competition, securities regulation, and gatekeeper liability has been published in a variety of leading journals in Israel and the United States, including the Yale Law Journal, California Law Review, Columbia Law Review, Cornell Law Review, Michigan Law Review, and Virginia Law Review. He was recently a member of Israel's Securities Authority, chair of the Committee on Institutional Investors and Capital Markets (Hamdani Committee), and advisor to the Committee on Institutional Investors' Investment in Bonds (Hodak Committee). Assaf Hamdani holds an LL.B. (summa cum laude) from the Hebrew University, Jerusalem, and an S.J.D. from Harvard Law School.
