All international law students are automatically eligible to receive an international partial tuition fee award (unless they are funded by a third party agency) from UBC in the amount of \$3260.84 per year for the duration of their program. There is no separate application process to receive this funding.

LL.M. (Common Law) student are to be self-funded and are not eligible to receive any awards or scholarships from UBC or the Faculty of Law.
